The Results of Unquenchable Worship

Acts 16:25-40

Reference verses

(Ephesians 5:20 Philippians 4:4)

No matter what happened to them: They worshiped.

No matter where they were: They worshiped.

No matter what time: They worshiped.

No matter who was there: They worshiped.

- 1) Unquenchable worship: draws others. (v.25)
John 12:32
- 2) Unquenchable worship: reaches heaven. (v.26)
Psalm 22:3
- 3) Unquenchable worship: sets the captive free. (v.26)
John 8:36 Romans 8:2 Galatians 5:1
- 4) Something in unquenchable worship will even wake those who sleep. (v.27)
Isaiah 55:11
- 5) Unquenchable worship: is our cry that there is still hope. (v.28)
2 Corinthians 5:17
- 6) Unquenchable worship: draws others to a desire for what you have. (Vs. 29-30)
Matthew 5:16 John 6:44
- 7) True unquenchable worship from a heart of thanksgiving will gain you respect. (v.30)

What brings you to the point of worship?

Is it a singer?

Is it a preacher?

Is it other people worshipping?

All of these are not necessarily bad, but unquenchable worship only comes when you are walking close to the one you worship.

Worship is about Trusting Him, Loving Him, Knowing Him, and Thanking Him (Jesus Christ).

The reason we worship is Him.

- * We worship Him for who He is and what He has done.
- * Others may enhance our worship.
- * Others may help lead us to a deeper worship.
- * Real worship is first and foremost an encounter with the Living and Holy God.

Worship: Proskuneo (Greek), pros-koo-neh-o: to kiss, like a dog licking his master's hand; to crouch, prostrate oneself in homage; do reverence, to adore.
